

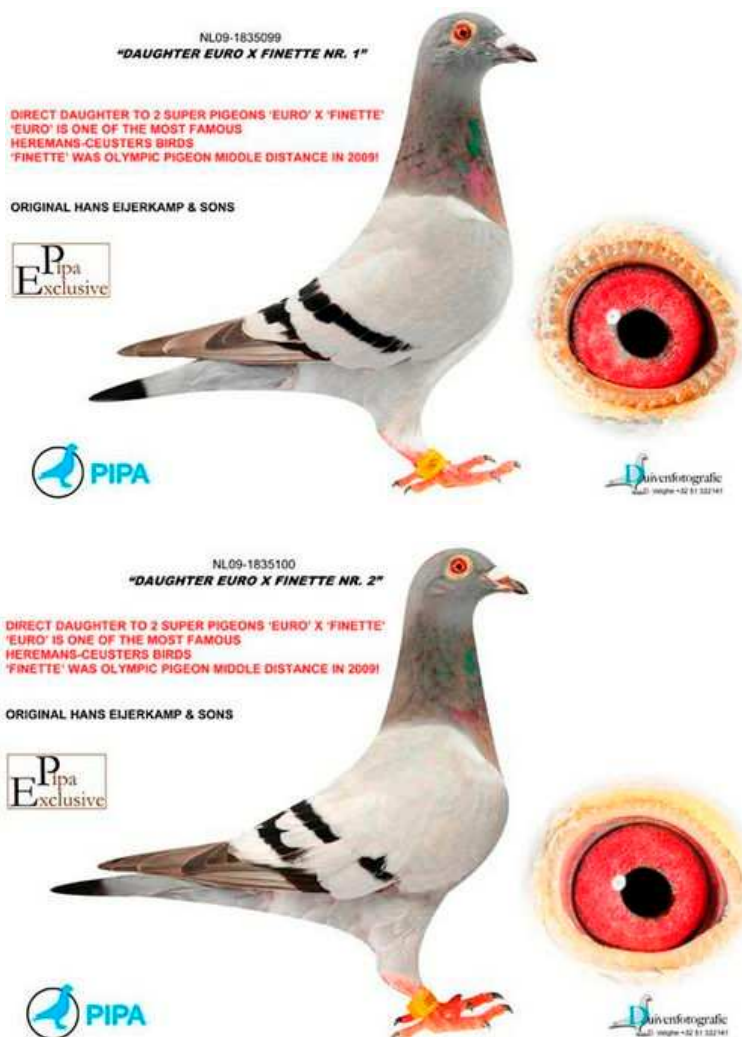


Sale 12 Eijerkamp birds out of Exclusive couplings now at PIPA

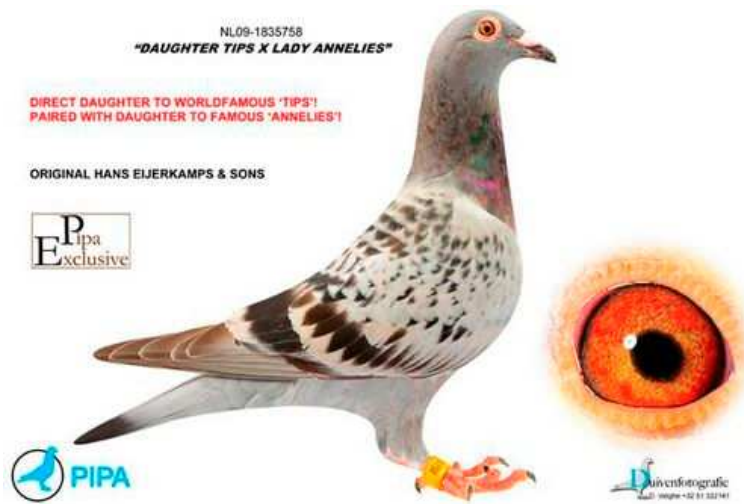

Fantastic season Team Eijerkamp 2009

2009 was again a glorious season for Team Eijerkamp with many top results as well on the short-, middle-, One-day- and long-distance.

In total 11 pure first prizes were won against an average of 3,716 birds.

The Eijerkamp birds won in this season 11 Top 10 National positions

- 3rd Nat. Bordeaux (943 km) 8,058 birds
- 3rd Nat. Blois (611 km) 6,275 birds

- 7th Nat. Blois (611 km) 6,275 birds
- 9th Nat. Chateauroux (671 km) 4,549 birds

In the Noordelijke-Unie, a new interprovincial competition with around 10,000 fanciers out of the Amalgamations 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11, Hans Eijerkamp and Sons became 1st Champion in the One-day distance races. By winning the 1st Not-nominated and 2nd Nominated championship the competition, with top fanciers as Nico-Jan Koenders, Pieter Veenstra, Sangers-Ung, C. and G. Koopman, E. Hoogland, Comb. Verbree etc, were left behind and so the first Champion trophy ever in this unique provincial competition will move to the Greenfield Stud.
